



## Lake Erie Islands Nature & Wildlife Center Nature Camp - Code of Conduct

The Lake Erie Islands Nature & Wildlife Center's staff is looking forward to providing a memorable and safe camp experience. We ask that campers and parents/guardians read and agree to abide by this code of conduct together before arriving at camp. Campers are expected to be respectful and contribute positively to the experience of fellow campers, as well as adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Inappropriate behavioral infractions will result in 3 verbal warnings then a call to parents.  
\*Campers will then be sent home. Behavior that warrants a warning includes:
  - a. Use of profanity
  - b. Disrupting program
2. There will be a zero tolerance policy for violence. \*No form of violent or inappropriate behavior will be tolerated and campers will be sent home. This includes:
  - a. Physically assaulting another camper or staff member
  - b. Verbally threatening another camper or staff member
  - c. Endangering the safety of fellow campers or counselors
  - d. Bullying or acts of aggression
  - e. Inappropriate physical contact
  - f. Damage to or theft of property/equipment
3. Campers should leave all electronic devices at home. Devices are only permitted for emergency use or with prior approval from LEINWC staff. If brought to camp, they will be collected and returned at the end of the session.
